

It's time to start our February **Kindergarten Homework**. I am sending a Homework Calendar home with your child today. Here is what you and your child need to do:

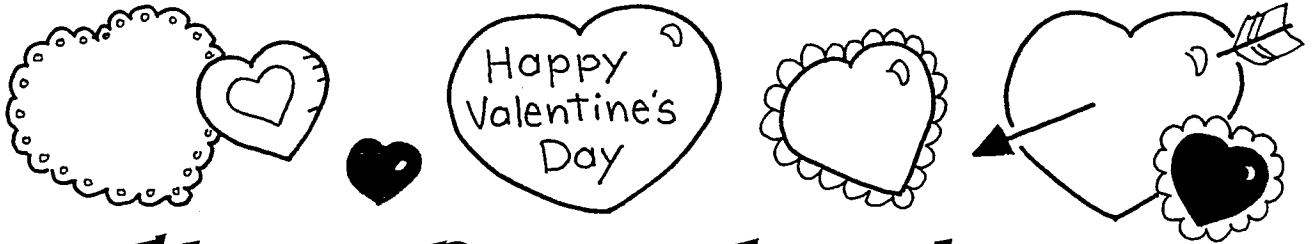
- Look over the activities on the calendar with your child. Have your child choose or "point" to an activity she/he would like to do.
