



Book Report Information

Book reports must be turned in on the day they are due to receive full credit. Points will be deducted for each day that a project is late.

September: Read a fiction book. Complete the Book Report Form. Make a poster about your book. Try to convince others to read this book.

October: Read a fairy tale book. Complete the Fairy Tale Book Report Form. Divide a poster into 3 parts and label the parts Beginning, Middle, End. Draw pictures and write what is happening in each part of the story.

November: Read a non-fiction book. Complete the "Noteworthy News" Book Report Form. Put items that relate to the story in a shoebox. Decorate the outside of the box to relate to your book. Include the title of your book on the outside of the box.

December: Memorize a poem and recite it to the class. The poem should have at least 8 lines. Make a mobile relating to your poem.

January: Read a biography. Complete the "Who's Who" Book Report Form. Dress up like the person you read about and tell the class about their life.

February: Read a fiction book. Make a diorama about your book. Use the paper called "My Book Box" as a guide for this project.

March: Read a non-fiction book. Complete the non-fiction book report form. Make a poster about the book. Include some interesting facts on your poster.

April: Read a mystery book. Complete the book report form called "A Mystery Solved!" Make a project of your choice to go along with your report.

May: Memorize a poem and recite it to the class. The poem should have at least 8 lines. Make a mobile relating to the poem.
