RE: College Credit Plus Program (formerly PSEO, Dual Credit)

During the 2019-2020 school year, Bellevue City Schools will be participating in the College Credit Plus program, (formerly PSEO, Dual Credit). This program enables your child to attend college classes at public institutions at no cost to you and earn high school/college credit for his/her efforts. There is a potential cost for participation at a non-public institution. **In order to participate in the College Credit Plus program, your student MUST meet college-readiness benchmarks on an admission assessment as well as the admission requirements of the school he/she chooses to attend.**

If you are interested in learning more about this opportunity and wish to participate in one of the two informational sessions scheduled for **January 9<sup>th</sup>** and **January 10<sup>th</sup>**, please return the completed form to the **guidance office** on or before January 7<sup>th</sup>. The form is included in this mailing.

**Attendance at a counseling session is expected of both you and your student in order to participate in the College Credit Plus program.** Your attendance, however, DOES NOT OBLIGATE participation in this program. If your child plans to participate in the program, you MUST inform the school of his/her intent to participate by **April 1, 2019**.

In order to ensure that all students and parents fully understand the possible consequences and benefits of College Credit Plus, the informational sessions will include the following topics:

- A. Program eligibility
- B. Process for granting academic credits
- C. Any necessary financial arrangements for tuition, books, and fees
- D. Criteria for any transportation aid
- E. Available support services
- F. Scheduling
- G. Consequences and benefits of participation

Please discuss this opportunity with your child and return the attached form to the **guidance office** if you and your student plan to attend one of the informational meetings. Remember that attendance at these counseling sessions does not obligate participation.
