Dear Parent/Guardian:

Ohio Graduation testing will take place the week of **March 10-14**. In order to provide the best environment for the students who will be testing, all juniors and seniors who have passed all portions of the OGT will be on a **two-hour delay**. **Those juniors and seniors who have yet to pass a portion of the test will be expected to report at 7:50AM on the day that portion is given.**

All freshmen and sophomores will report to the high school at normal testing time with testing beginning at 7:50AM. The freshmen will take an OGT and PSAT practice test in order to give our district base-line data to identify areas of strength and weakness. The test results will allow us to focus on those areas in preparation for the OGT and PSAT next school year.

The sophomores will be taking the OGT. Meeting proficient standards on all five parts of the test is a requirement for graduation. They will be assigned to classrooms and supervised by classroom teachers. The teachers will monitor the tests and will record time spent on each test for each student. As you know, the stakes of this test are very high and it is our intent to provide the most conducive testing environment for our students.

BUSSING WILL NOT BE EFFECTED. Those students who ride the bus, but are not taking any part of the exam, may either ride the normal route and report to the cafeteria for study hall or arrange their own transportation.

The order of testing is as follows: Monday, March 10-Reading; Tuesday, March 11- Mathematics; Wednesday, March 12-Writing; Thursday, March 13-Science; Friday, March 14-Social Studies. Make-ups will be conducted during the week of March 17-21.
