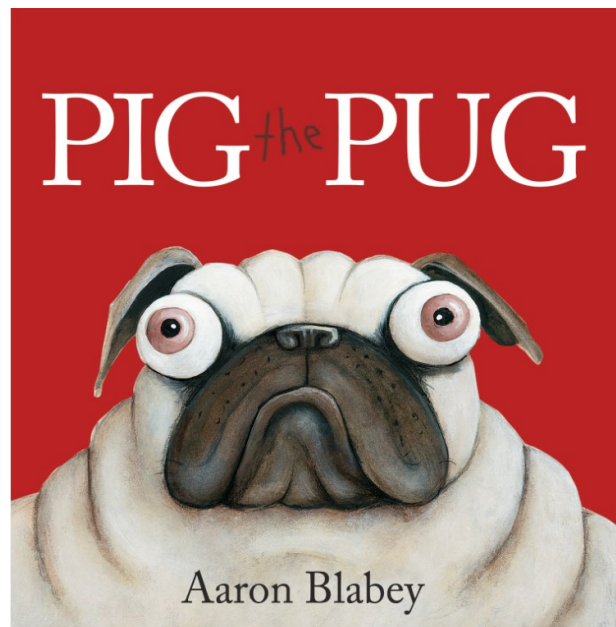
## PTO News
