Pre-School

The Bellevue Schools Preschool, a state recognized 5-star Step-Up to Quality program, is a public preschool. Educational programming is based on the Early Learning & Development Standards. The program serves children three to five years of age, including children with special needs. Morning and afternoon sessions are available up to five days per week. Income eligibility requirements may apply.

Social Worker and Counselor

The Elementary Guidance Program provides a variety of services to children, staff and parents both on an individual, group, and classroom basis. They provide staff and parents with additional resources regarding students' social-emotional needs. Mrs. Miller is also our District Social Worker and serves as a link between the home, school and community. She attends collaborative meetings in Sandusky and Huron Counties focused on bullying, drug awareness and other mental health issues. Mrs. Miller's dog, "Ace", is a full time therapy dog in our school district.
