There are many activities you can draw! Students are encouraged to include themselves in the drawing.

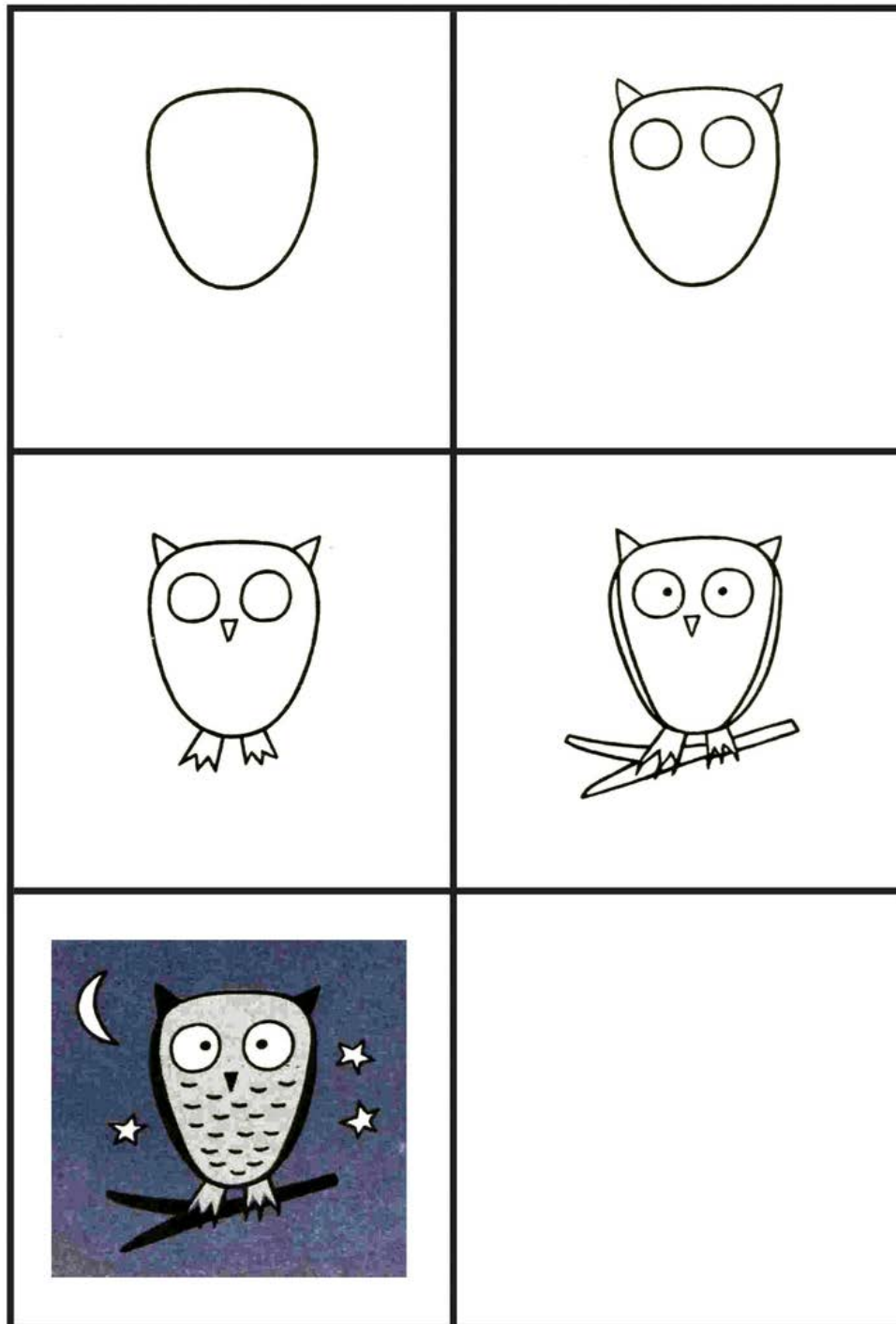

Night Owl Drawing Practice*

Below is a step-by-step guide for parents and students to look at while drawing an owl in front of the night sky! This allows for children to practice their lines and shapes such as circles, triangles, and ovals. Once the owl is finished, students are encouraged to create a moon and stars behind the owl to make the drawing look more finished!

Color is greatly encouraged but if supplies are short, a pencil drawing will be great!

*The practice of drawing Penguins with basic shapes.*

After the practice of the night owl, learners can use those skills to transition into the creation of a penguin! Below is a step-by-step example of how to draw a basic penguin. Students are encouraged to add a background and color for their creation!
