



The school district was approved in July 2009 to make energy conservation upgrades at the high school under the House Bill 264 program sponsored by the Ohio School Facilities Commission. Under this program, a loan is secured by the district to pay for the energy improvements. The energy savings from these improvements are used to pay back the annual loan payment. This program is totally separate from the new middle and elementary school buildings.

Energy improvements included new boilers, HVAC upgrades, temperature controls and lighting retrofits. The final energy component was the wind turbine which was completed in December 2010. The chart above shows the savings the district has experienced in electricity and heating costs.
