HYBRID/REMOTE LEARNING GENERAL ROLES

We believe that everyone has a part to play in hybrid and remote learning.

In order to be successful, students will

- actively engage in their learning.
- complete all assignments.
- submit their completed work timely.
- attend live meetings when possible; watch recorded live video if unable to attend.
- view all pre-recorded videos.
- respond to teacher feedback and email timely (24 hours).
- communicate any issues, extension requests, or questions as they arise.

In order to support your student's success, parents/caregivers will

- stay informed of your student's academic expectations and progress.
- assist and support your children's at-home educational needs.
- keep in communication with teachers and the school.
- reach out when assistance is needed and kindly allow 24 hours for a teacher response to email/phone calls received during the school week.
- create a dedicated work space (clean table top) with good lighting.
- set a consistent schedule/routine that works for your family.

PARENT/CAREGIVER INSTRUCTIONS FOR NAVIGATING GOOGLE CLASSROOM

Bellevue Schools use [Google Classroom](#) as its learning management system for grades K-12. All Google Classrooms are linked to school issued student Gmail accounts.

Students will access Google Classroom by logging into their school-issued Gmail accounts and clicking on the waffle app in the right top corner of the Gmail screen. When your student is logged in, please navigate to these areas with your student:

- Scroll for announcements/important updates under the “**Stream**” tab.
- View assignments under the “**Classwork**” tab.
- Review the “**Resources**” section under the **Classwork** tab for general class information, helpful links, videos, and tutorials.
- Review your student’s Google Calendar for an overview of all assignments due.
- View any parent tutorials for additional navigational help.
- Google Classroom will not provide grades. Please check ProgressBook for grades.
